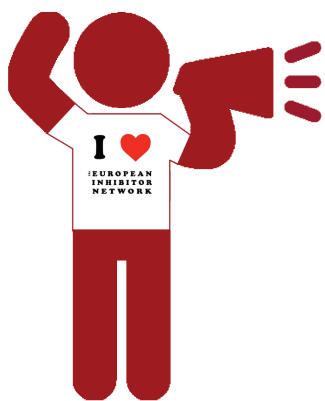


HERE ARE A FEW TIPS TO HELP YOU FULFILL THIS ROLE BETTER:

- 1 Follow the developments in the EIN and inform your NMO regularly.
- 2 Promote the various activities of the EIN within your NMO. Where possible we will provide you with templates that you will be able to adapt to the context of your NMO for better promotion.
- 3 At least once in 6 months or whenever it is relevant **share the information about events, initiatives or publications related to people with inhibitors** in your country/NMO with the EHC Inhibitor Working Group.
- 4 Promote the on-line community of the EIN and seek to recruit new participants to join the platform.
- 5 Work with your NMO to include an information and discussion session about inhibitors at one of its annual events to keep the interested persons attracted.
- 6 Seek to **establish an Inhibitor group within your NMO** to give people with inhibitors a place within the NMO and stimulate collaboration and exchange.
- 7 Establish contacts with the Inhibitor Ambassadors in other NMOs and look to organize regional meetings for people with inhibitors. EHC Activity Grants can be used for this purpose*.
- 8 Work with the medical community to reach out to people with inhibitors. You can write a letter asking them to inform the incoming patients about your work or leave a brochure in the waiting room, for example.

→ * Only the NMO can apply for the Activity Grants, but you can propose the project to your NMO!
