WHAT IS AN INHIBITOR AMBASSADOR?

Inhibitor Ambassador is a person, nominated by the EHC National Member Organisation or NMO, whose main role is to be **the active link** between the people with inhibitors in his/her country and the EIN on the European level, and who **follows the developments** in the EIN and informs the NMO regularly; **promotes the various EIN activities** within the NMO; and **shares the information about relevant initiatives/publications** on the national/ regional level within the EIN.
