Since the first EHC Inhibitor Summit in 2016, more than 200 patients and their families and health care professionals from 27 countries have come together to share their experiences and learn from one another.

The purpose of the Inhibitor Summit is to offer a special time and space for people with haemophilia who have inhibitors, as well as their family members and care givers to build a community, educate and empower themselves and to improve the quality of their lives. In addition, the summit offers a possibility to spend time in a relaxing environment and enjoy the activities together.

The programme of the Inhibitor Summit consists of both informational and practical parts. An important part of the programme is dedicated to peer-to-peer sessions and exchange between the participants.

In addition, the EHC strives to accommodate a variety of needs:

- Russian interpretation for the participants from the Russian-speaking part of the community.
- Special activity programmes are designed for children and teenagers, with the necessary language support provided by the volunteers of the respective NMOs.
- Socialising and evening programmes are facilitated.
