'Finding ways for better inclusion of people with inhibitors in the life of the National Member Organisations'

EHC Annual Conference is the one occasion during the year that brings together the great variety of people involved in the work of the European Haemophilia Consortium (EHC) — its National Member Organisations (NMOs), clinicians and other experts, as well as patients themselves.

The European Inhibitor Network (EIN) is building on this momentum to bring the inhibitor community to the table by organising a Pre-Conference workshop to take place a day in advance of the EHC Annual Conference. The participants of the workshop are further invited to attend the EHC Annual Conference.

The workshop aims to explore the challenges with ensuring participation of people with inhibitors (PWI) in the life of the EHC NMOs and seeks to **develop tailored action plans for inclusion and involvement** of PWI in the NMOs taking part in the workshop. During this workshop interactive and engaging approach is employed to ensure better exchange of ideas, examples and tools for inclusion and involvement of PWI, offer peer support and stimulate cross-border initiatives.

For the success of the workshop it is essential that both people with inhibitors and senior NMO leaders are present at the workshop. This way the ideas generated can be brought to the decision making bodies easier and the work on implementation can start sooner.
