It seeks to **understand and address** the personal and systemic challenges people who have haemophilia with inhibitors face:

- lack of information,
- insufficient treatment,
- mobility constraints,
- social and financial barriers,
- psychosocial impact, etc.

It aims at **building a European community** of people with inhibitors and their families and caregivers – because the numbers nationally are too small.

It will work closely with medical experts **towards a framework** for treatment and care that could possibly bridge the gaps of inhibitor treatment in Europe.
